BOGOTA – Jim Viola, husband of Patricia Viola, missing since Feb. 13, 2001, is planning a rally and tribute, “Road to Remember, 2010 Missing Persons Tour” 11 a.m.-4 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 21, at 70 Chestnut St., in the borough.

Monica Caison and the Community United Effort (CUE ) volunteers are expected to arrive at approximately 1 p.m.

The tribute is also planned to honor and provide exposure and awareness that Patricia is still missing, but not forgotten, to provide information about Patricia (photos, flyers, DVDs, buttons, business cards, etc.) and other state

missing persons, generate tips to find out what happened using coverage from friends in the media, provide child finger Kit I.D. Cards (courtesy of the Bogota police) and to provide free safety (Internet, travel, etc) handouts, also in Spanish, crime prevention and missing person literature.

Speeches and a balloon release for Patricia are also planned. Free bottled water will be available.
